

# Patients with Huntington's Disease Wanted for Brain Network Study **Age 18 to 65**

This is research study at Beth Israel Deaconess Medical Center, run by Dr. Simon Laganieri. The study assesses brain networks through functional magnetic resonance imaging (MRI) to look at changes in blood flow from baseline during attentional tasks.

- The study involves 3 MRI visits over 18 months (2-3 hours per visit).
- Subjects will be asked to undergo several cognitive and motor assessments; MRI, during which they will be asked to complete behavioral/attentional tasks; a neurological exam; and several questionnaires.
- Study Eligibility: Subjects must be English-speaking, 18-65 years old, have a confirmed genetic diagnosis of Huntington's disease, and in good overall health without cognitive impairment, dementia, or any neurologic or psychiatric condition (outside of Huntington's Disease)
- Subjects will be compensated for their participation.
